We are thrilled to have you be part of our exciting club and look forward to you being a valued member.

By joining the club, your children are entitled to some great opportunities, from coaching to competition, and lots of fun along the way.

#### **Starting Out**

All ages and skill levels are welcome to join. Our clinics and competitions are based on skill levels, and provide new golfers with both support and incentive to progress to the next level.

#### **Divisions**

The five junior divisions start with 3-hole competitions for our youngest and newest players, and as their skills improve they can progress to longer competitions across 6 holes, 9 holes, 13 holes and 18 holes. Juniors are moved up into the next division as their handicap shows they are ready. This helps them build their skills at their own pace yet keeps them at a competitive level.

#### **Clinics**

Our club professional Jeffrey Hoy holds free golf clinics for juniors each Monday afternoon after school. These clinics are designed to accommodate children of all ages who want to learn the basics. Clinics are also available for more advanced young golfers to help them fine tune their game. You will see your child build up in confidence and pick up the fundamentals of golf very quickly after attending these clinics.

## Cost

Getting started in golf has a very low basic outlay. We provide new players with access to clubs or low-cost starter sets are available from our pro shop. Then as your child plays more you can add extra clubs to their kit – it's then up to your budget on how much you want to spend.

We aim to keep membership fees to a minimum and golf to a maximum:

- Rockhampton Golf Club Membership Fee – Gives you access to the club and course to play and practice as much as your child wishes
- Junior Club Sign On – Gives your child membership to the junior golf club and includes a Rockhampton Junior Golf Club shirt
- Competition Fees – Payable when your child would like to play in the junior club competitions. (\$5 entry fee to cover weekly prizes)

<b><u>Player/Parents</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>All players are to be a financial member of the Rockhampton and Rockhampton Junior Golf Club</li><li>Players without an official handicap will not be eligible to win the competition prizes.</li><li>Any player caught cheating will automatically be disqualified/suspended from the competition. Repeated offenses may result in being excluded from participating in future competitions. <b>NO WARNING AND NO EXCEPTIONS.</b></li><li>Any player or caddie (including parents) who disrupts play, abuses the course or behaves in a manner not becoming to the etiquette of golf may be referred to the Junior Golf Club Committee for further actions</li><li>All air swings are to be counted towards the score and are not deemed as practice swings.</li><li>The Committee allows authorised officials to scrutinise any junior players score, after consultation with the player and their markers.</li><li>All serious complaints must be delivered to the Rockhampton Golf Club Junior Coordinator, who will forward the complaint on to the Rockhampton Golf Club Match Committee.</li></ul>	
<b><u>Dress Code</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Players should always adhere to the Rockhampton Golf Clubs dress code when participating in events<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>➤ <b>Boys:</b> Collared golf shirts and tailored shorts or pants – football shorts are not allowed</li><li>➤ <b>Girls:</b> Collared golf shirts and tailored shorts, skirts or pants - No exposed midriiffs.</li><li>➤ <b>All players</b> must wear closed in shoes and a hat or cap.</li></ul></li></ul>	
<b><u>Smoking</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Junior golfers are <b>NOT</b> permitted to smoke at all. Parents smoking should do so in the designated smoking areas.</li><li>Government Smoking Ban at Under 18 Sporting Events: Due to the smoking ban in place whilst on the Golf Course with your children you must be 10 meters away from the fairway to have a cigarette, or 10 meters from all competitors on the course. This also includes e-cigarettes.</li></ul>
